Local Requirements

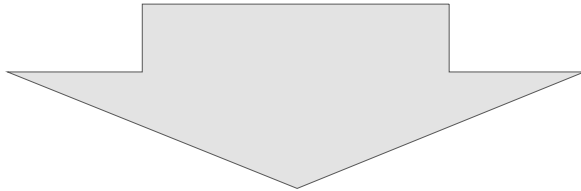

Sign Permits. Contact the Marshall City Building Official, City Engineer's Office, (507) 537-6773.

Transient Merchant Permits. Obtain from the City Clerk's Office, (507) 537-6763.
