

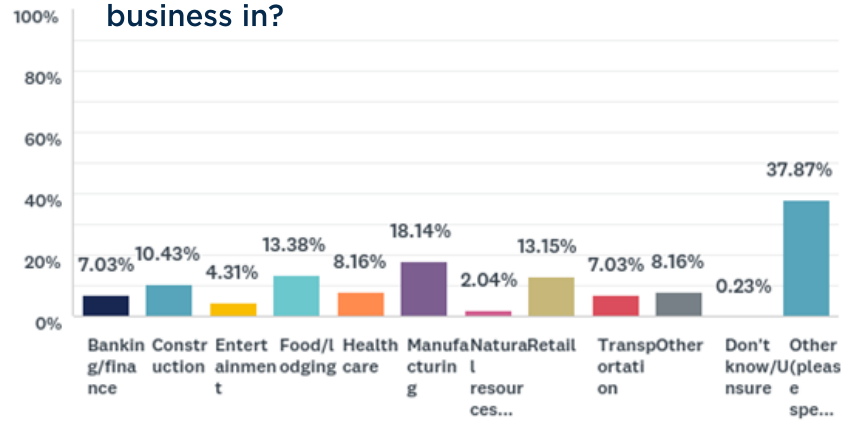
COVID-19 Business Toolkit Survey

482 respondents answered a series of 18 questions.



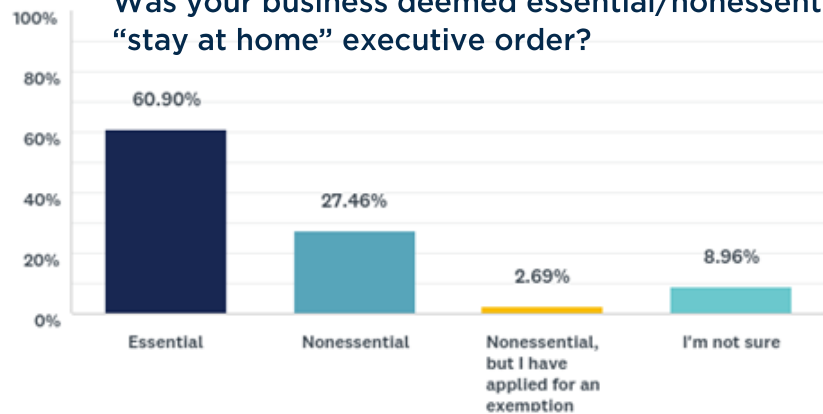
What sector does your company or organization do business in?



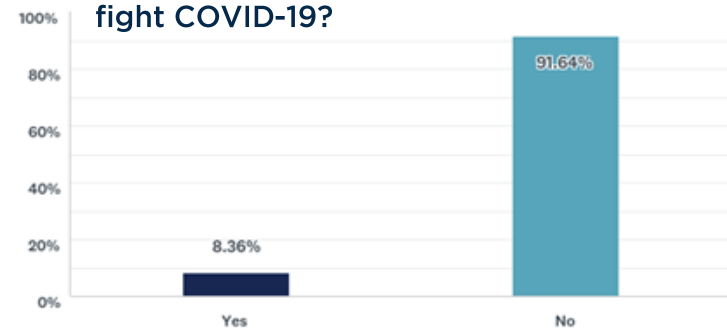
Has the COVID-19 outbreak changed your company's outlook for 2020?



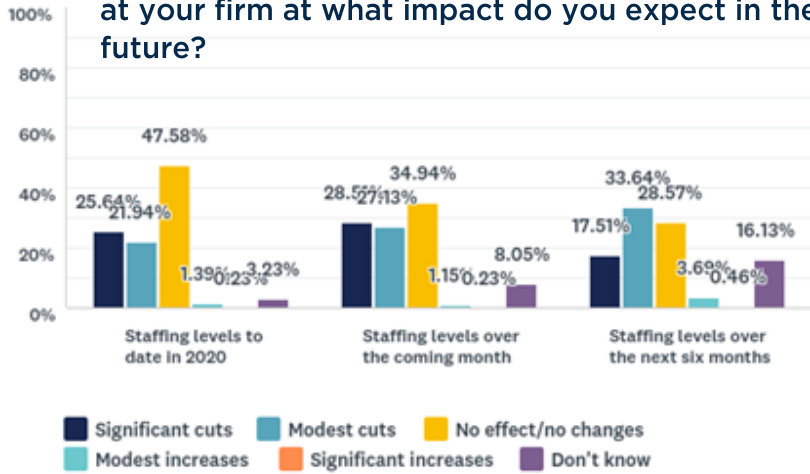
Was your business deemed essential/nonessential for the "stay at home" executive order?



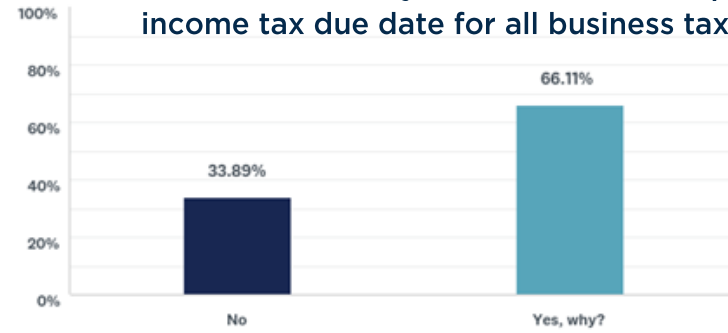
Are you currently or considering changing your business practices to manufacture critical goods to fight COVID-19?



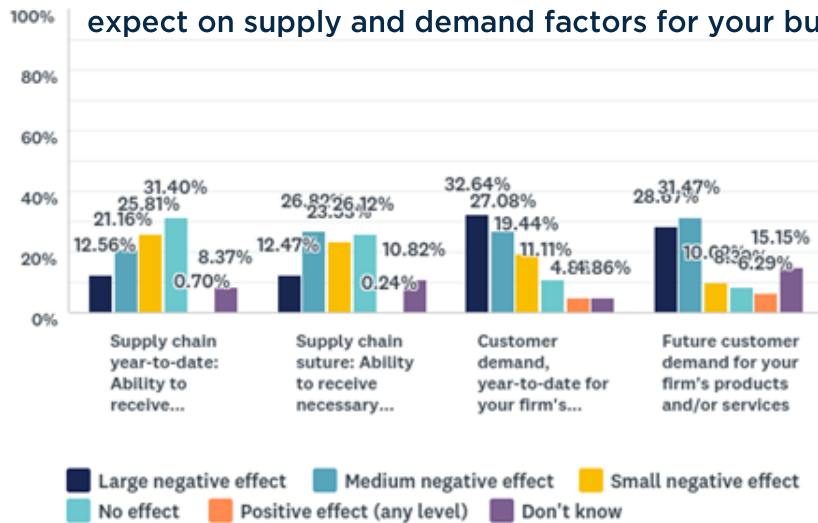
What effect has COVID-19 had on current staffing levels at your firm at what impact do you expect in the near future?



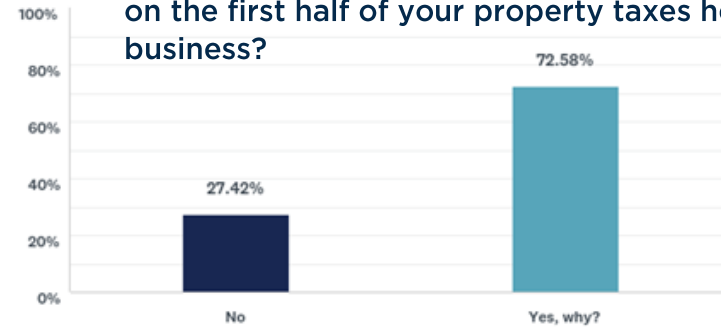
Would it help your business if Minnesota matched the federal 90-day extension for the April 15 income tax due date for all business taxpayers?
